CMSgt Dana C. Council is the Command Chief Master Sergeant, 355th Wing, Davis-Monthan Air Force Base, Ariz. He is the principle enlisted advisor for one of the largest installations and flying operations in the United States Air Force, for more than 46,000 personnel, 152 aircraft, and 51 billion dollars in assets. He advises the installation commander and staff on mission effectiveness, professional development, military readiness, training, utilization, health, morale, and welfare of the command's 5,200 enlisted Airmen. The 355th Wing operates the A-10 Thunderbolt II, HH-60G, and HC-130J as well as three Guardian Angel squadrons comprising the Rescue and Attack mission. The wing has units at Davis-Monthan AFB, Ariz. and Nellis AFB, Nev. Additionally, CMSgt Council provides leadership and direction for Total Force support to Active Duty, Guard, Reserve, Customs and Border Patrol agencies encompassing 34 mission partners and 11,000 Airmen.

CMSgt Council is a native of Philadelphia, Pa. He entered the Air Force in February 1994. His background includes various leadership positions at the squadron, group, wing and major-command levels. Additionally, CMSgt Council has deployed in support of Operations SOUTHERN WATCH, IRAQI FREEDOM, ENDURING FREEDOM and INHERENT RESOLVE.

Prior to his current assignment, CMSgt Council served as the Command Chief, 386th Wing, Ali Al Salem Air Base, Kuwait.
