COLONEL JOSEPH C. TURNHAM

Col Joseph C. Turnham is the Commander of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization's Train, Advise, Assist Command-Air and the 438th Air Expeditionary Advisory Group in Kabul, Afghanistan. In these roles he leads a 1,251-person joint, coalition, and contract team from 13 nations in training, advising, and assisting Afghanistan with developing an independent, integrated, and professional Air Force.

Colonel Turnham comes from a long line of veterans dating back to the American Revolution. After growing up in the Air Force he received his commission through Officer Training School. Since then he has served three operational tours in the Pacific, one in Europe, and six combat tours in the Middle East. Colonel Turnham is a joint service officer who has commanded at the flight, squadron, and group levels. He is a command pilot with 3,300 hours in the A-10, including more than 1,100 combat hours over Afghanistan, Iraq, and Syria.
