SOLICITATION FOR INTEREST
RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD
ENVIRONMENTAL RESTORATION PROGRAM
AT DAVIS-MONTHAN AIR FORCE BASE, ARIZONA

The United States Air Force issues this notice to solicit interest in establishing a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) at Davis-Monthan Air Force Base.

The Air Force periodically conducts a RAB assessment at installations where a formal RAB does not exist. The assessment will determine if there is sufficient and sustained community interest in forming a RAB for the Environmental Restoration Program (ERP) at an installation. The RAB is a forum for the discussion and exchange of ERP information between Department of Defense installations, regulatory agencies, and the community. The RAB will cover all ERP activities associated with Davis-Monthan AFB and only those activities. Members from the local communities, State of Arizona, and Federal Regulatory Agencies are invited to submit notification of interest by January 12, 2022.

The Air Force recognizes the importance of stakeholder and community participation. A RAB is intended to improve public information and participation by sharing project updates with and receiving input from interested and impacted communities. Appointed RAB members will meet regularly for activities including, but not limited to, reviewing and commenting on environmental documents and activities for all Davis-Monthan AFB ERP projects. RABs can influence cleanup decisions through discussion and valuable input provided to installation decision makers, but they do not make restoration decisions. All RAB meetings will be open to the public.
